



Important Safety Instructions:

- Please read all instructions carefully before assembling.
- For your safety, assembly by two or more adults is strongly recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.
- Use only vendor supplied hardware to assemble. Using unauthorized hardware could jeopardize the structural integrity of the item.

Pre-assembly:


- Remove all parts and hardware from the box and lay out on a clear carpeted or scratch-free work surface, as this will avoid damaging parts during assembly. The shipping box provides an ideal work surface.
- Do not dispose of any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is completed to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Use the parts and hardware lists below to identify and separate each of the pieces included.
- The illustrations provided allow for easier assembly when used in conjunction with the assembly instructions.
- The use of power tools to aid in assembly is not recommended. Power tools can damage hardware and split wood.




Assembly Instruction Steps:

- 1. Carefully place the Media Base into the upright position, as seen in the illustration below
- 2. If the Media Base does not sit level, adjust the levelers (up or down) at the bottom of Base to level the Media Base, as seen in the illustration below.

- 3. Whenever there is a need to change the height of the adjustable shelf, please follow these steps below:
- A. Unscrew the Wood Screws found under the shelf bottoms and remove shelves from support pegs and remove shelves from shelf support pegs.
- B. Remove the shelf support pegs and insert them into the corresponding holes of the new desired position.
- C. Place the shelf onto the shelf support peg and make sure each shelf is stable.
- D. Insert the original wood screws through the holes of the shelf support pegs and into the pre-drilled holes on the shelves.
- E. Tighten the screws using a Philips head screwdriver (not provided). Do not over tighten.




4. NOTE: Installation of the Anti Tip Kit is REQUIRED. Please follow the separate instructions to secure the Media Base to the wall- using the tipping-restraint kit included

Multiple Media Base can be combined together by following the assembly instructions below:

- 5. Place the Media Base in the desired location.
- 6. Align the Media Bases together.
- 7. Placing a Metal Plate (A) over metal insert holes on the rear side of Media Base as seen below.
- 8. Insert with 4 pieces of Screw (B) through each pre-drilled holes on Metal Plate, and into metal insert holes on Media Base.
- 9. Tighten all screws with a Phillip head screw driver (not included).

Care Instructions:

- Dust often using a clean, soft, dry and lint-free cloth.
- Blot spills immediately and wipe with a clean, damp, cloth.
- We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives or furniture polish on our lacquered finish.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight.
 Re-tighten if necessary.
