






ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:


1. Place Front/Back Rails (B), Side Rails (A), and Center Rail (C) upside down, as shown in Fig. 1. Secure the Front/Back Rails (B) to the Side Rails (A) using (8) Bolts (E).




2. Secure the Center Rail (C) to the Front/Back Rails (A) with Screws (F), using Philips Head Screwdriver as shown in Fig. 2.



3. Turn the lounge frame upright. Secure the Slats (D) to the frame with Screws (F), using Philips Head Screwdriver. Tighten all screws and bolts.



4. Two or more Square Lounge Frames can be joined together, if desired, using (2) U-Shaped Metal Connectors (H) as shown.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- For daily care wipe with a soft dry cloth. Blot Spills immediately and wipe with a clean dry cloth.
- Store in a dry, covered area when not in use.
- We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives, or furniture polish.
- Over time, the product may begin to gray. To nourish the wood, wash with soap and water. When dry, apply a coating of teak oil with a clean cloth. Remove excess oil by blotting with a soft, clean cloth.
