
- Please read all instructions carefully before assembling this XW Dresser.
- For your safety, assembly by two or more adults is strongly recommended.
- Keep these instructions for future use.
- Use only vendor-supplied hardware to assemble this item. Using unauthorized hardware could jeopardize the structural integrity of the item.

Pre-assembly:

- Remove all parts and hardware from the box. Place all items on a carpeted or scratch-free work surface, as this will avoid damaging parts during assembly. The shipping box provides an ideal work surface.
- To avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware, do not dispose any packaging or contents of the shipping carton until assembly is complete.
- Use the parts and hardware lists below to identify and separate each of the pieces included.
- The illustrations provided allow for easier assembly when used in conjunction with the assembly instructions.
- The use of power tools to aid in assembly is not recommended. Power tools can damage the hardware and split the wood.







Assembly Instruction Steps:

- 1. Place the XW Dresser (A) down onto a soft, flat surface, as seen in the illustration below.
- 2. Thread the [4] Turned Legs (B) and Center Leg (C) into the cut-outs located on the bottom posts of XW Dresser (A), as seen below.



- 3. With the help of another person, stand the XW Dresser upright.
- 4. If the XW Dresser does not sit level, adjust the levelers (up or down) at the bottom of the posts to level the Dresser, as seen in the illustration below.



5. <u>NOTE: Installation of the Anti Tip Kit is REQUIRED</u>. Please follow the separate instructions to secure the Desk to the Wall, by using the tipping-restraint kit included.




6. For use with changing pad

Place the changing pad directly on top of the dresser. Insert wood screw (D) through each strap, into pre-drilled holes on the back panel and secure as shown below.




Changing pad to the left
